Placement FAQs

Where do BCC graduates find jobs?

- 231 students are employed, or 47.83%
- The unemployment rate was 2.89%
- 52.15% found employment directly related to their field of study
- An additional 21.98% found employment indirectly related to their field of study
- Of those finding employment directly related to their field of study:
 - 73.5% work in Broome County
 - 15.5% work in the Southern Tier, but beyond Broome County
 - 5.8% work elsewhere in New York State
 - 5.2% work outside of New York State
